- Exclusive enterprise story that highlighted the health disparities of Black pregnant people giving birth, while speaking to a partner about his loss and medical experts about why the racial gap exists.
- Reported from the Mexico border leading up to the end of Title 42, including interviews with asylum seekers through the border wall and an activist in Tijuana who owns a migrant shelter.
- Build connections with both the Jewish and Islam communities in San Diego to make for faster and trusted sources in storytelling during Israel-Hamas war.
- Conducted multiple live interviews during a wildfire evacuation with people who spent the night in their cars or at a school gym. Only reporter who stayed to provide live updates by interviewing the district superintendent and Red Cross.
- In-depth coverage of the Bunny Fire, including speaking with evacuees and fire officials at the scene.
- Two days coverage from the frontlines of the three-day Kaiser strike, reporting from the picket lines.
- Provided continuous live shots from San Diego International Airport during holiday flight disruptions and finding new angles, such as luggage delays and legal rights of passengers.
- Secured exclusive in-person interview with a mother who survived a stabbing and carjacking.
- Live reports during winter storms, changing locations to capture the most impactful footage.

- Established contacts with the House of Ukraine, a local non-profit that has been helping Ukrainian refugees, who provide exclusive leads for stories.
- Secured interview with the father of a boy who suffered a severe brain injury and followed his recovery progress until his return home.
