- Develop weekday content including web articles, live shots, and weather topicals.
- Cross-promote digital content in on-air segments, driving viewers to online articles.
- Supported team through staffing challenges by serving as meteorologist for weekend mornings and evenings, with a 4-hour turnaround time into Sunday mornings.
- Covered four tornado warnings solo in studio for about two hours on a weekend morning, using radar on the Baron system.
- Covered a southern winter storm, which brought snow and ice to Savannah for the first time in seven years. Built winter weather graphics from scratch for the team, leaning on prior weather experience in Upstate New York.
- Produce and deliver content for the annual Hurricane-Safety Guide.
- Led morning coverage of Tropical Storm Debby, which caused heavy rain and flooding throughout viewing area. Delivered hourly updates at the top of the hour during the morning shift for three days straight.
- Led morning coverage of Hurricane Helene, which caused heavy rain, flooding, high winds, and tornadoes throughout the viewing area. Delivered hourly updates at the top of the hour during the morning shift for two days straight.
- Lead school tours through the studio, educating students about broadcast meteorology.
- Visit schools to present to children on topics such as forecasting, severe weather safety, and climatology.
